My dear Parish Family,

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year Blessings! In this season of get-togethers and celebrations Visitation parish family is grateful to you for all that you are doing for our church. Thank you. Our common theme for this year of 2024 was "Grow your tent" (Isiah 54:2). We have grown in number and in quality—thank you for your involvement. The last four years we worked so hard to renovate, repair, and rebuild our Church building and the campus. Now it's time to "RENEW" ourselves - the temple of God. On Sunday, December 1st, Bishop Raica, lighting a candle (which stays lit at the Sanctuary), inaugurated our "Year of Renewal". He blessed the side altars and blessed and opened the new wheel chair access door welcoming everyone back to Visitation. This year we individually and collectively make an effort to renew our life practicing Virtues daily.

We completed all our plans for 2024 as we grew our Tent in quantity and quality:

Outside the Church: We renovated the office building both inside and outside. The ditch in the courtyard was filled and a deck on the mote was built. The Memorial Brick Prayer Garden, gas light lantern, permanent gazebo as hospitality center, and the Columbarium were built and are in use. The works for the history marker Obelisk is in progress; parking lot expansion is in progress; and boundary marker fencing is in progress, Signage is completed. Parking lot repair, respraying, and restriping was done in all three parking lots.

Inside the Church: Stained glass windows were repaired and refurbished. Pews were refinished. Kneelers were reupholstered and new carpet installed. New sound boxes and system were installed. New side altars were built and the wheel chair access door was completed.

Thank you again for your support and involvement in building the Visitation faith community. You have been a blessing to Visitation and to me personally. In this Christmas and New Year when you gather at your kitchen table please do know you are sitting at the extension of the Sacred Altars of Visitation. Thank you for the gift of your marriage and family. May the Holy Family bless and protect each and every one of you. I am honored to be your pastor.
